





1. Parent to Parent Support Team
2. Your PTA can create or purchase a Buddy Bench
3. Awareness Events (Autism, Dyslexia, Downs Syndrome)
4. Teacher Grants for sensory items for the classroom
5. Participate in Reflections Art Program
