

Where Do We Start? Governing Documents (Bylaws)

Article VI: Officers and Their Election

Section 1. Each officer of this PTA/PTSA shall be a member of this PTA/PTSA.

Section 2.

- a. The officers of this association shall consist of a president, ____ (number) vice-president, a recording secretary, a corresponding secretary, a treasurer.
- b. Officers shall be elected by ballot annually in the month of _____. However, if there is but one nominee for any office, election for that office may be by show of membership cards or voice vote. A majority vote shall elect.
- c. With the exception of the treasurer, officers shall assume their official duties following the end of the school year and shall serve for a term of one year or until successors are elected. The treasurer shall assume all duties after the books have been audited.
- d. A person shall not be eligible to serve more than two consecutive terms in the same office.

- Identify Who Will Present the Slate of Officers
- Prepare the Agenda
 - Welcome (Call to Order)
 - Adoption of Previous Meeting Minutes
 - Report of Officers
 - Report of Board of Directors
 - Treasurer's Report
 - Unfinished Business
 - New Business
 - Report of the Nominating Committee
 - Elections (Secretary to Read Article VI of Bylaws)
 - Announcements
 - Adjournment





The Election Meeting cont'd.

During the Meeting

- Proceed According to the Agenda & Script
- Receive the Report of the Nominating Committee (Slate of Officers)
- Take Additional Nominations
 - For Each Office, Close Nominations
 - Does Not Require a Motion or Second
 - Allow Opportunity for Candidates to Introduce Themselves





How Do We Vote?

Ways to Vote

- By Ballot/Anonymous Poll
- By Voice

Sample Verbiage

- Uncontested Election: "All those in favor of electing the slate of officers as presented (list candidates and offices), say aye (pause). Any opposed, say no."
- Election By Acclamation (uncontested): "Seeing that there is only one nominee for the office of ---, you have elected John Smith by acclamation."
- Contested Election: "Each member will mark one selection for each office on your ballot/poll."
